**C6B** = slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K3, then K3 from cable needle; **C6F** = slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, K3, then K3 from cable needle.

### FINISHED SIZE

Completed scarf is 24.5 cm (9¾ in) wide and is 220 cm (86½ in) long.

## YARN

## NEEDLES

4½mm (no 7) (US 7) circular needle no more than 40 cm long **OR** set of 4 double-pointed 4½mm (no 7) (US 7) needles

5½mm (no 5) (US 9) circular needle no more than 40 cm long **OR** set of 4 double-pointed 5½mm (no 5) (US 9) needles

## TENSION

18 sts and 20 rounds to 10 cm measured over patterned st st, 16 sts and 24 rounds to 10 cm measured over st st, both using 5½mm (US 9) needles.

## FINISHED SIZE

Completed hat is 54.5 cm (21½ in) in circumference and 20.5 cm (8 in) deep with rib brim folded over.

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**M1L** = make a stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch with left needle inserting point of needle from front to back of this loop, then

**knitting** into back of this loop; **M1LP** = make a stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch with left needle inserting point of needle from front to back of this loop, then **purling** into back of this loop; **M1R** = make a stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch with left needle inserting point of needle from back to front of this loop, then **knitting** into front of this loop; **M1RP** = make a stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch with left needle inserting point of needle from back to front of this loop, then **purling** into front of this loop.
