## Flying Saucers fingerless gloves

Size: 7-8, to fit the average lady's hand circumference (above thumb) approx. 20 cm

Yarn:
100g Schoppel-Wolle FLYING SAUCERS
shade 2113 ( $75 \%$ wool, $25 \%$ nylon, $420 \mathrm{~m} / 100 \mathrm{~g}$ )
Needles:
Set of 3 mm double-pointed needles.
Pair 3 mm needles.
(or size required to achieve gauge)
Stitch markers.
Gauge: 30 sts $\times 42$ rows $=10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ over stocking stitch

Using 3 mm needles cast on 56 sts.
Divide sts evenly onto 4 needles $=14-14-14-14$ sts.
Join to knit in the round, being careful not to twist the sts.
Round 1: *K1, p1, rep from * to end.
This round forms the rib. Work in rib for 12 cm (or desired length).
Change to stocking st, maintaining stitches on needles 1 and 4 for the palm of the hand and stitches on needles 2 and 3 for the back of the hand. Work 2 rounds.

## Shape thumb gusset

Still working in the round: either side of the $1^{\text {st }}$ st of the palm (needle 1) m 1 by picking up the crosswise strand between sts and knitting into the back of it = 3 thumb sts.
Continue increasing this way: inc 2 sts every $3^{\text {rd }}$ row (there will be 2 more sts between the increasings each time), until there are 17 sts for the thumb gusset.
Work 2 rounds, then place the 17 sts for the thumb on a stitch holder and return to knitting in the rnd, casting on 3 sts in place of the thumb sts $=58$ sts.
Work 2 rounds, then on the $3^{\text {rd }}$ rnd work across 3 cast on sts as folls: $\mathrm{sl} 2, \mathrm{k} 1$, psso $=56$ sts. After 11 cm in stocking st begin to knit fingers.

## Shape little finger

Take the last 6 sts of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ needle (palm) and the first 6 sts of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ needle (back od hand) onto a separate needle. Rejoin yarn, cast on 2 sts for in between fingers in addition to the 12 sts $=14$ sts. Join to knit in the round, knit to the required length and cast off.

## Ring finger

Rejoin yarn, knit the last 7 sts of the palm, pick up and knit 2 sts from base of little finger and knit up 6 sts from back of hand, cast on 2 new sts for in between fingers $=17$ sts. Knit in the rnd to the desired length and cast off.

## Middle finger

Rejoin yarn, knit the last 7 sts of the palm, pick up and knit 2 sts from base of ring finger and knit 8 sts from back of hand, then cast on 2 new sts for in between fingers $=19$ sts. Knit in the rnd to the desired length and cast off.

## Index finger

Rejoin yarn, knit the rem 7 sts from the palm, pick up and knit 3 sts from base of midde finger and knit the rem 8 sts from the back of hand, cast on 2 new sts. Knit in the rnd to the desired length and cast off.

Thumb
With RS facing slip 17 sts from stitch holder onto needle, pick up and knit 3 sts at inside of thumb $=20$ sts. Join to knit in the rnd. K nit to the desired length and cast off.

Knit second glove in the same way.
