

Hook Link User Guide



The Hook Link is a device that allows the fast rigging of strops, straps, ropes and bridles. It is a safe and fast replacement for shackles, is easy to store and easy to use.

They are available in two versions, Standard and 7075 Pro. Each has a different breaking strain.

This breaking strain is clearly marked on the Hook Link. Please be sure to check your Hook Link to see which version you have.

NEVER EXCEED THE BREAKING STRAIN

If it looks likely you might exceed the breaking strain, you must stop. Change your rigging or use a device that is rated for your expected load.

NEVER USE A HOOKLINK FOR A SNATCH RECOVERY

Hook Links are not designed for snatch recovery and we strongly advise they are not used for this purpose.

NOT FOR LIFTING

Hook links are not designed for lifting and should not be used for this purpose.

ALWAYS ENSURE YOUR ANCHOR POINT OR RECOVERY POINT IS SUITABLE FOR YOUR INTENDED USE

Weak, or damaged anchor and recovery points can be very dangerous, always carefully examine any before use and discard any recovery points or materials that are damaged or dangerous.
