A mixture of fine abrasives dispersed in a water based lubricating medium, to produce a non-flammable, non-toxic liquid, which removes white rings / marks and brings back new life to old tired French polish etc.

Directions

Apply sparingly with a soft dry cloth, working on a small area at a time. Polish with a Clean, soft cloth.
