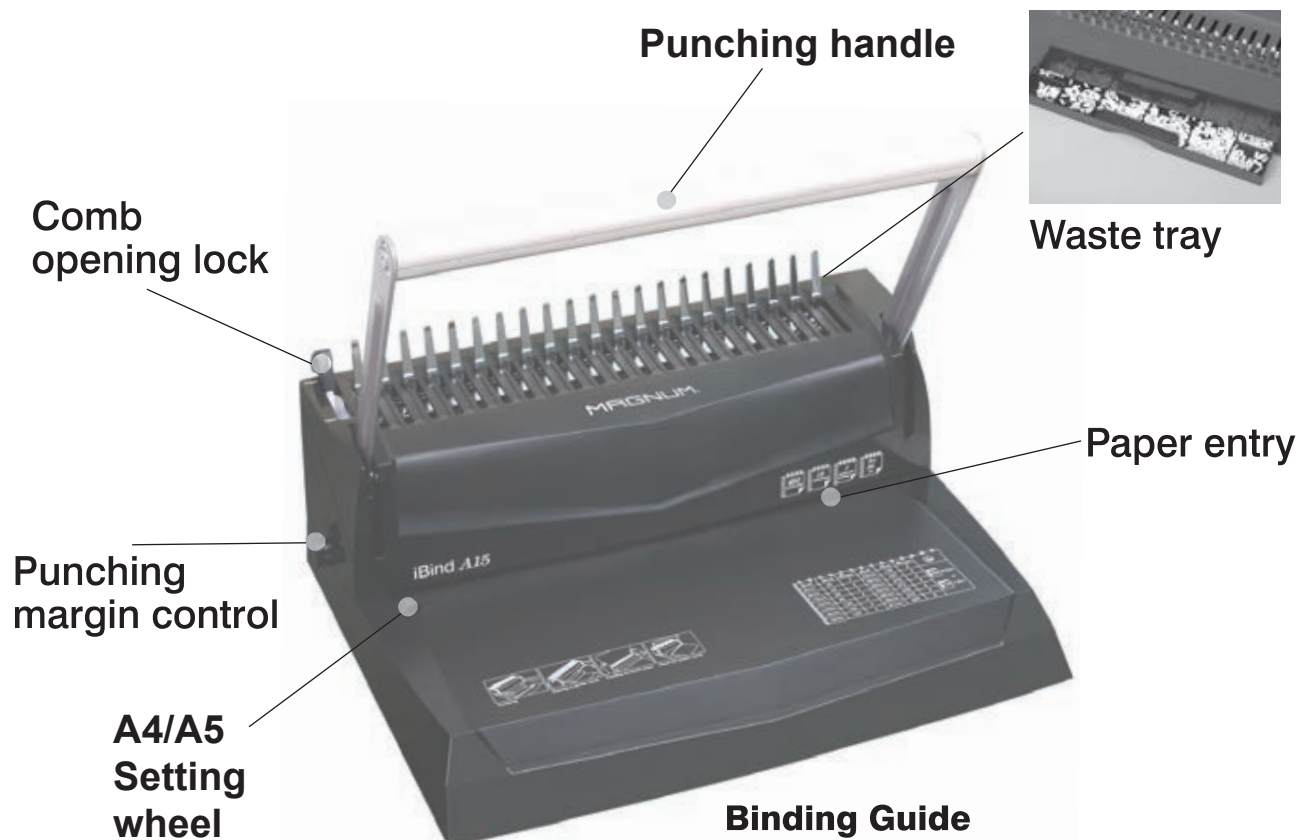

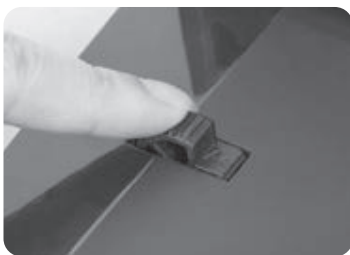
General Safeguards

- Place your comb binder on a stable surface.
- Use the machine only for its intended purpose of punching and binding paper and document covers according to the indicated specifications.
- Always test the machine with some scrap paper before punching the final document.
- Take care that there are no staples or such like in the documents to be bound.
- Empty the waste tray regularly.
- Lift the machine from the bottom, not the cover or the handle.
- Unauthorized maintenance is not allowed.

Note: Please do not insert a binding comb until you finish punching papers and covers of the required booklet.



(Fig. 1)
Punching preparation:
Turn the **Wheel** to set
A4/A5 paper



(Fig. 2)
Punching preparation: Pull
the **Punching margin control**
from 2mm to 5mm



(Fig. 3)
Insert paper (max. 15 sheets
of 80gsm at one time) into
the **Paper entry**



(Fig. 4)
Pull the **Handle** all the way
down until it stops to punch
completely through paper



(Fig. 5)
Insert and open a comb. Pull
over the **Comb opening lock**
to the "OPEN" position



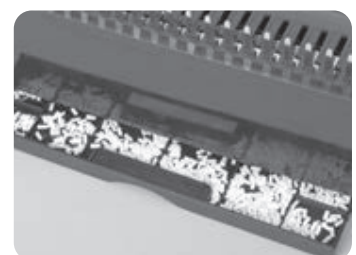
(Fig. 6)
Load punched sheets directly
onto the opened comb



(Fig. 7)
When finished, release the
Comb opening lock and
return the **Handle** to the
original position



(Fig. 8)
Remove the bound booklet



(Fig. 9)
Empty the **Waste tray**

Warranty & Incorrect Use

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Your Magnum Binding System should reach you in perfect condition, however please retain all of the original packaging once you have unpacked your Binding System in case you need to return it for repair. If your system arrives damaged or faulty in anyway, this must be reported to your supplier immediately. If the Binding System is sent back for repair under warranty and is damaged in transit due to faulty packaging your warranty may be void.

The Binding System you have purchased includes a 1 year warranty on defective parts and general wear and tear, it does not cover any damage to the punch blades through misuse or operator error due to incorrect substrates being punched.
