What you will need:

RED HEART® Holiday: 2 Balls
00140 White/Met. Silver

Crochet Hook: 6mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 13 sts = 10
cm [4"] in double crochet. CHECK
YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any
size hook to obtain the tension/
gauge.

Falling Snowflakes Crochet Scarf

*A string of snowflakes
crocheted in one piece provides a
fabulous holiday scarf. The sparkling yarn
makes them stand out even more.*

Scarf measures 15 cm [6"] wide by 162 m
[64"] long, blocked.

SCARF

Ch 201.

Row 1: Dc in third ch from hook and each ch
across, turn – 199 dc.

Row 2: First Fan – Ch 1, dc in first 4 dc, ch
3, skip next 2 dc, dc in next dc, turn, ch 3
(counts as tr), work 6 tr in ch-3 space, slip st
in dc to the left of ch-3 space, ch 1, turn, dc
in first tr, ch 3, [dc in next tr, ch 3] across next
5 tr of Fan, dc in top of beginning ch-3, ch 1,
slip st in next dc after the ch-3 space – 6 ch-3
spaces; First Fan made, *work dc in next 6 dc,
Second Fan – ch 3, skip next 2 dc, dc in next
dc, turn, ch 3 (counts as tr), work 6 tr in ch-3
space, slip st in dc to the left of ch-3 space, ch
1, turn, dc in first tr, ch 3, [dc in next tr, ch 3]
across next 5 tr of Fan, dc in top of beginning
ch-3, ch 1, slip st in next dc after the ch-3
space; repeat from * across, dc in each of next
3 dc, slip st in end of last dc – 22 Fans across
row.

Row 3: Turn to work along opposite edge of
foundation ch, ch 1, dc in each of first 4 ch
sts, First Fan – ch 3, skip next 2 ch, dc in next
ch, turn, ch 3 (counts as tr), work 6 tr in ch-3
space, slip st in dc to the left of ch-3 space, ch
1, turn, dc in first tr, ch 3, [dc in next tr, ch 3]
across next 5 tr of Fan, dc in top of beginning
ch-3, ch 1, slip st in next dc after the ch-3
space – 6 ch-3 spaces; First Fan made, *work
dc in next 6 ch, Second Fan – ch 3, skip next
2 ch, dc in next ch, turn, ch 3 (counts as tr),
work 6 tr in ch-3 space, slip st in dc to the left
of ch-3 space, ch 1, turn, dc in first tr, ch 3,
[dc in next tr, ch 3] across next 5 tr of Fan, dc
in top of beginning ch-3, ch 1, slip st in next
dc after the ch-3 space; repeat from * across,

dc in each of last 3 ch, slip st in first st along
opposite side to join – 22 Fans along opposite
edge of ch; 44 Fans total.

Picot Round: Beginning in First Fan of Row 2,
*ch 3, dc in first ch-3 space of Fan, (ch 5, slip
st in 3rd ch from hook – first picot made, [ch
3, slip st in 3rd ch from hook] twice, slip st
in same ch of first picot, ch 2 – trident picot
made), [dc in next ch-3 space, ch 3, dc in next
ch-3 space, work trident picot] twice, dc in
last ch-3 space of Fan, ch 3, skip next 2 dc
in Row 1, dc in next dc*; repeat from * to *
across to last st, turn to work along opposite
side; repeat from * to * across opposite side,
slip st to first st to join.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block Scarf so trident picots
lie flat.

Abbreviations

ch = chain; cm = centimeters; dc = double
crochet; mm = millimeters; st(s) = stitch(es);
tr = triple or treble crochet; [] = work
directions in brackets the number of times
specified; * or ** = repeat whatever follows
the * or ** as indicated.
