What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\circledR}$ Anne Geddes ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ : 1 ball each of 00556 Jam A, 00764 Taffy B, 00203 Daffodil C, 00261 Tangerine D, and 00691 Grass E

Double Pointed Knitting Needles: 5.5 mm [US 9]

Crochet Hook: 6 mm [US J-10]
Stitch holder, stitch marker, yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 15 sts = 10 cm [4"] in Garter stitch holding 2 strands of yarn together. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the tension/gauge.

Whooo's the next baby that needs a hat? This cute hat is picture perfect for both little girls and little boys! Hat is first knit and then edging and trims are crocheted.

Directions are for size Small (6-9 months); changes for Medium (12 months) are in parentheses.

Finished Size: 34.5 (40.5) cm [13½ (16)"] head circumference

## HAT

## Earflap (Make 2)

With 1 strand each of $\mathbf{A}$ and $\mathbf{B}$ held together, cast on 2 sts.
Row 1: Knit across.
Row 2 (Right side): K1, yo, K1-3 sts.
Row 3: Knit across.
Row 4: K1, yo, knit across - 4 sts.
Row 5: Knit across.
Row 6: Knit across to last st, yo, k1 - 5 sts.
Rows 7-10(14): Repeat last 4 rows 1 (2) more times: 7 (9) sts.
Rows 11 (15)-12 (16): Repeats Rows 3 and 4: 8 (10) sts.

Slip all sts onto stitch holder and set aside. Leave stitches of second Earflap on needle.

## BODY

Round 1 (Right side) (Joining Round): Knit across 8 (10) sts of second Earflap, cast on 22 (24) sts, knit 8 (10) sts of first Earflap from stitch holder, cast on 14 (16) sts - 50 (60) sts. Divide stitches evenly over double pointed needles. Join, being careful that sts are not twisted, and begin working in the round. Place marker for beginning of round.
Round 2: Purl around.
Round 3: Knit around.
Rounds 4-22 (26): Repeat Rounds 2 and 3 for $9(11)$ times, then Round 2 once more.

## CROWN SHAPING

## Size Medium Only

Round 1 (Right side): (K10, k2tog) 5 times 55 sts.
Round 2: Purl around.
Round 3: Knit around.
Round 4: Purl around.
Round 5: (K9, k2tog) 5 times: 50 sts.
Rounds 6-8: Repeat Rounds 2-4.

## All Sizes

Round 1 (9): [K8, k2tog] around - 45 sts.
Round 2 (10): Purl around.
Round 3 (11): Knit around.
Round 4 (12): Purl around.
Round 5 (13): [K7, k2tog] around - 40 sts.
Round 6 (14): Purl around.
Round 7 (15): Knit around.
Round 8 (16): Purl around.
Round 9 (17): [K6, k2tog] around - 35 sts.
Round 10 (18): Purl around.
Round 11 (19): Knit around.
Round 12 (20): Purl around.
Round 13 (21): [K5, k2tog] around - 30 sts.
Round 14 (22): Purl around.
Round 15 (23): [K4, k2tog] around - 25 sts.
Round 16 (24): Purl around.
Round 17 (25): [K3, k2tog] around - 20 sts. Round 18 (26): Purl around.
Round 19 (27): [K2, k2tog] around - 15 sts. Round 20 (28): Purl around.
Round 21 (29): [K1, k2tog] around - 10 sts. Round 22 (30): Purl around.
Round 23 (31): K2tog around -5 sts.
Round 24 (32): Purl around.
Cut yarn, leaving a $25.5 \mathrm{~cm}[10$ "]. Thread yarn needle with end and weave through remaining stitches. Draw up firmly, fasten securely.

## FINISHING

## Edging

With crochet hook and right side of Hat facing, join 1 strand each of $\mathbf{C}$ and $\mathbf{D}$ held together with dc on Row 1 of either Earflap.
Round 1 (Right side): Dc evenly around Hat edge, working 1 dc in each st around and 3 dc around Row 1 of each Earflap, join with slip st to first dc.
Round 2: Ch 1, slip st in each dc around, join with slip st to first slip st; fasten off.

## EYE (Make 2)

With crochet hook and 2 strands of $\mathbf{E}$ held together, ch 3.
Round 1 (Right side): 11 tr in 3rd ch from hook (skipped chs count as first tr), join with slip st to first tr - 12 tr. Fasten off.
Round 2: With 2 strands of $C$ held together, Ch 2 (counts as first htr), htr in same st, 2 htr in each tr around - 24 htr
Fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing. Thread yarn needle with Eye long end. Using photo as a guide, sew wrong side of Eye to right side of Hat. Repeat for second Eye.

## BEAK

With crochet hook and 2 strands of $\mathbf{D}$ held together, ch 5.
Round 1 (Right side): 2 dc in 2nd ch from hook (skipped chs count as first dc), htr in next 2 chs, 3 dc in last ch, turn; htr in next 2 foundation chs, join with slip st to first dc. Fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing. Thread yarn needle with Beak long end. Using photo as a guide sew wrong side of Beak to right side of Hat.

## CROWN TASSEL

Cut eight, 30.5 cm [12"] strands each of C and D. Fold strands in half lengthwise. Using photo as a guide, insert crochet hook in Crown of Hat and draw up a loop. Thread strand ends strands through loop and pull to tighten. Repeat, attaching 2 more Tassels to Crown of Hat. Trim tassels to about 3 " $(7.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ long.

## EARFLAP TASSEL (Make 2)

Cut twelve, 51 cm [20"] strands each of C and D. Fold strands in half lengthwise. Using photo as a guide, insert crochet hook in Earflap of Hat and draw up a loop. Thread strand ends strands through loop and pull to tighten. Repeat for second Earflap. Trim tassels to about $6.5 \mathrm{~cm}\left[21 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right]$ long.

## Abbreviations

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; ch = chain; $\mathbf{c m}=$ centimeters; dc = double crochet; htr = half treble crochet; $\mathbf{k}=$ knit; $\mathbf{k 2 t o g}=$ knit 2 sts together; mm = millimeters; $\mathrm{p}=$ purl; st(s) = stitch(es); $\boldsymbol{\operatorname { t o g }}=$ together; $\mathbf{t r}=$ triple or treble crochet; yo = yarn over; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
