What you will need:

RED HEART® Anne Geddes Baby™: 5 balls 00691 Grass A, 3 balls 00203 Daffodil C, 1 ball each 00261 Tangerine B, 00764 Taffy D, 00504 Robin E, 00112 Night-Night F

Note:
The cocoon will use 3 balls of 00691 Grass and the blanket will use 2 balls of 00691 Grass.

Crochet Hooks: 4mm [G-6] and 5.5mm [-9 US]

Yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 12 sts = 10 cm [4"]; 8 rows = 10 cm [4"] in Wing pattern stitch using larger hook and holding 2 strands of yarn together. **CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the tension/gauge.

Butterfly Baby Blanket & Cocoon

That baby that makes your heart flutter will look picture perfect in this cocoon with butterfly-winged blanket. Crochet it in beautiful shades of Anne Geddes Baby for a memorable baby gift.

Blanket: Top wingspan measures 137 cm [54"] wide and top wing to lower wing measures 106.5 cm [42"] long, at outer edges

Special Stitch

long-tr (Long treble crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch 2 rows below, yarn over and draw up a loop (to current row height), [yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

Note: Do not work into the corresponding stitch in the current working row.

long-dc (Long double crochet) = Insert hook in end of indicated row, yarn over and draw up a loop (to current row height), yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook.

Note: Do not work into the corresponding stitch in the current working row.

dc2tog = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

dc3tog = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] three times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

tr2tog = [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] twice, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

NOTES

To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color.

BLANKET

Butterfly Body

With larger hook and 2 strands of **A** held together, ch 2.

Row 1 (right side): Work 3 dc in 2nd ch from hook, turn – 3 dc.

Row 2: Ch 1, dc in first dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in last dc, turn – 4 dc.

Row 3: Ch 1, dc in each dc, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, dc in first dc, 2 dc in each of next 2 dc, dc in last dc, turn – 6 dc.

Row 5: Ch 1, dc in each dc, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, dc in first dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in last dc, turn – 8 dc.

Rows 7-9: Ch 1, dc in first st, 2 dc in next st, dc in each st to last 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in last st, turn – 14 dc at end of Row 9.

Row 10: Ch 3 (counts as first tr here and throughout), tr in each dc, turn – 14 tr.

Row 11-16: Repeat Rows 9 and 10 three times, turn – 20 tr at the end of Row 16.

Row 17: Ch 1, dc in each tr, turn.

Row 18: Ch 3, tr in each dc, turn.

Rows 19-60: Repeat Rows 17 and 18 twenty-one times.

Row 61: Ch 1, dc in each tr, turn.

Rows 62-66: Ch 1, dc in next dc, dc2tog, dc in each dc to last 3 dc, dc2tog, dc in last dc, turn – 10 dc.

Row 67: Ch 1, dc in each dc, turn.

Rows 68-71: Repeat Row 9 – 18 dc.

Rows 72-77: Ch 1, dc in each dc, turn.

Row 78: Ch 1, dc in next dc, dc2tog, dc in each dc to last 3 dc, dc2tog, dc in last dc – 16 dc. Fasten off.

Top Left Wing

With larger hook and 2 strands of **D** held together, ch 41.

Row 1: Dc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch – 40 dc.

Row 2 (right side): Ch 3, tr in each dc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, dc in first tr, 2 dc in next tr, dc in each tr, turn – 41 dc.

Row 4: Repeat Row 2.

Row 5: Repeat Row 3; change to **E** – 42 dc. Fasten off **D**.

Continued...



Please Note: Print this pattern using Landscape Orientation.

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Row 6: Ch 3, tr in next dc, *long-tr in next tr 2 rows below, tr in next 2 dc; repeat from * to last dc, tr in last dc, turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, dc in each tr; change to **A**. Fasten off **E**.

Row 8: Ch 3, tr in next dc, *long-tr in next tr 2 rows below, tr in next 2 dc; repeat from * across, turn.

Row 9: Repeat Row 3; change to **C** – 44 dc. Fasten off **A**.

Rows 10–21: Repeat Rows 2 and 3 six times – 50 dc at end of Row 21.

Row 22: Repeat Row 2.

Row 23: Ch 1, dc in each tr, turn.

Row 24: Repeat Row 2.

Rows 25–26: Repeat Rows 23 and 24.

Row 27: Ch 1, dc in each tr to last 3 tr, dc2tog over next 2 tr, dc in last tr, turn – 49 dc.

Row 28: Ch 3, tr2tog, tr in each dc, turn – 48 tr.

Rows 29–40: Repeat Rows 27 and 28 six times – 36 tr at end of Row 40.

Row 41: Ch 1, dc in next tr, dc2tog, dc in each tr to last 3 tr, dc2tog, dc in last tr, turn – 34 dc.

Row 42: Repeat Row 28 – 33 tr.

Rows 43 and 44: Repeat Rows 41 and 42; change to **B** at end of Row 44 – 30 tr at end of Row 44. Fasten off **C**.

Rows 45–49: Ch 1, dc in first st, dc2tog, dc in each st to last 3 sts, dc2tog, dc last st, turn – 20 dc.

Row 50: Ch 1, dc in next dc, dc2tog, dc in last dc, turn – 19 dc.

Row 51: Ch 1, dc to last 3 dc, dc2tog, dc in last dc – 18 dc. Fasten off.

Top Right Wing

With larger hook and 2 strands of **D** held together, ch 41.

Row 1: Ch 1, dc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch, turn – 40 dc.

Row 2 (right side): Ch 3, tr in each dc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, dc in each tr to last 2 tr, 2 dc in next tr, dc in last tr, turn – 41 dc.

Row 4: Ch 3, tr in each dc, turn.

Row 5: Repeat Row 3; change to **E** – 42 dc. Fasten off **D**.

Row 6: Ch 3, *long-tr in next tr 2 rows below, tr in next 2 dc; repeat from * to last 2 dc, long-tr in next tr 2 rows below, tr in last dc, turn.

Row 7: Repeat Row 3; change to **A** – 43 dc. Fasten off **E**.

Row 8: Ch 3, tr in next dc, *long-tr in next tr 2 rows below, tr in next 2 dc; repeat from * to last 2 dc, long-tr in next tr 2 rows below, tr in last dc, turn.

Row 9: Repeat Row 3; change to **C**, turn – 44 dc. Fasten off **A**.

Rows 10–21: Repeat Row 2 and 3 six times – 50 dc at end of Row 21.

Row 22: Repeat Row 2.

Row 23: Ch 1, dc in each tr, turn.

Row 24: Repeat Row 2.

Rows 25–26: Repeat Rows 23 and 24.

Row 27: Ch 1, dc in first tr, dc2tog, dc in each tr, turn – 49 dc.

Row 28: Ch 3, tr in each dc to last 3 dc, tr2tog, tr last dc, turn – 48 tr.

Rows 29–40: Repeat Rows 27 and 28 six times – 36 tr at end of Row 40.

Row 41: Ch 1, dc in next tr, dc2tog, dc in each tr to last 3 tr, dc2tog, dc in last tr, turn – 34 dc.

Row 42: Repeat Row 28 – 33 tr.

Rows 43 and 44: Repeat Rows 41 and 42; change to **B** at end of Row 44 – 30 tr at end of Row 44. Fasten off **C**.

Rows 45–49: Ch 1, dc in first st, dc2tog, dc in each st to last 3 sts, dc2tog, dc in last st, turn – 20 dc.

Row 50: Ch 1, dc in each dc to last 3 dc, dc2tog, dc in last dc, turn – 19 dc.

Row 51: Ch 1, dc in next dc, dc2tog, dc in each dc – 18 dc. Fasten off.

Top Left Wing Border

With right side facing and larger hook, join 2 strands of **F** held together with slip st to end of Row 1 of top left wing.

Row 1: Ch 1, work 71 dc evenly across ends of rows to Row 51, dc in each dc of Row 51, dc 71 st evenly across ends of rows of second edge – 160 dc. Fasten off **F**.

Row 2: With right side facing, join **E** with dc in first dc, dc in next 2 dc, *long-dc in end of next row, dc in next 3 dc; repeat from * across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, *dc in next 9 dc, 2 dc in dc; repeat from * across – 176 dc. Fasten off **E**.

Row 4: With right side facing, join **F** with dc in first dc, dc in next 42 dc, *dc in next dc, htr in next dc, tr in next dc, (2 tr, ch 2, slip st in top of 2nd tr, tr) in next dc, tr in next dc, htr in next dc, dc in next dc, slip st in next st; repeat from * 9 more times, dc in remaining dc. Fasten off.

Top Right Wing Border

Work same as top left wing border for Rows 1–3.

Row 4: With right side facing, join **F** with dc in first dc, dc in next 52 dc, *dc in next dc, htr in next dc, tr in next dc, (2 tr, ch 2, slip st in top of 2nd tr, tr) in next dc, tr in next dc, htr in next dc, dc in next dc, slip st in next st; repeat from * 9 more times, dc in remaining dc. Fasten off.

Bottom Wing (make 2)

With larger hook and 2 strands of **B** held together, ch 2.

Row 1: Work 3 dc in 2nd ch from hook, turn – 3 dc.

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in last dc, turn – 5 dc.

Rows 3–5: Ch 1, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc to last 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in last dc, turn – 11 dc.

Row 6: Ch 1, dc in each dc, turn.

Rows 7–26: Repeat Rows 3–6 five times;

change to **E** at end of Row 26 – 41 dc. Fasten off **B**.

Rows 27–34: Repeat Rows 3–6 two times; change to **D** – 53 dc. Fasten off **E**.

Row 35: Ch 3, tr next dc *long-tr in next dc 2 rows below, tr next 2 dc; repeat from * across, turn.

Row 36: Ch 1, dc in each tr, turn.

Row 37: Ch 3, tr in each dc, turn.

Row 38: Ch 1, dc in each tr; change to **F**, turn. Fasten off **D**.

Row 39: Ch 1, dc in each dc; change to **C**, turn. Fasten off **F**.

Row 40: Repeat Row 35.

Row 41: Ch 1, dc in next tr, dc2tog, dc in each tr to last 3 tr, dc2tog, dc in last tr, turn – 51 dc.

Row 42: Ch 3, tr in each dc, turn.

Rows 43–54: Repeat Rows 41 and 42 six times – 39 dc.

Row 55: Repeat Row 41 – 37 dc.

Rows 56–59: Ch 1, dc in next dc, dc2tog, dc in each dc to last 3 dc, dc2tog, dc in last dc; change to **F** at end of Row 59, turn – 29 dc. Fasten off **C**.

Rows 60–62: Repeat Row 41 – 45 dc. Fasten off.

Bottom Wing Border

With right side of bottom left wing facing and larger hook, join 2 strands of **F** held together with slip st to end of Row 35.

Round 1: Ch 1, dc in same end of row as joining, working evenly across ends of rows and across Row 62, *dc in next dc, htr in next dc, tr in next dc, (2 tr, ch 2, slip st in top of 2nd tr, tr) in next dc, tr in next dc, htr in next dc, dc in next dc, slip st in next st; repeat from * 11 more times, dc in remaining ends of rows, working 3 dc in Row 1; join with slip st to first dc. Fasten off.

Repeat for bottom right wing border, joining **F** with slip st to end of Row 39.

Top Wing Decorations

Large Flower (make 2)

With smaller hook and 1 strand of **E**, ch 4.

Round 1 (right side): Work 11 tr in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch count as first tr); join with slip st to top of beginning ch-3 – 12 tr. Fasten off **E**.

Round 2: Join **F** with slip st to any tr, ch 3, tr in same st as joining, 2 tr in each remaining tr around; join with slip st to top of beginning ch-3, turn – 24 tr.

Round 3: Ch 3, tr in first tr, tr in next tr, *2 tr in next tr, tr in next tr; repeat from * around; join with slip st to top of beginning ch-3, turn – 30 tr.

Round 4: Ch 1, dc in first tr, htr in next tr, 3 tr in next tr, htr in next tr, dc in next tr, slip st in next tr, *dc in next tr, htr in next tr, 3 tr in next tr, htr in next tr, dc in next tr, slip st in next tr; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first dc – 40 sts. Fasten off.

Pink Curl (make 12)

With smaller hook and 1 strand of **D**, ch 21, work 6 tr in 2nd ch from hook, tr in next 6 chs, htr in next 6 chs, dc in next 4 chs, slip st in last ch. Fasten off.

Blue Circle (make 4)

With smaller hook and 1 strand of **E**, ch 4.

Round 1 (right side): Work 11 tr in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch count as first tr); join with slip st to top of beginning ch-3 – 12 tr. Fasten off.

Round 2: Join **E** with slip st to any tr, ch 3, tr in same st as joining, 2 tr in each remaining tr around; join with slip st to top of beginning ch-3, turn – 24 tr. Fasten off **E**.

Round 3: Join **F** with dc to any tr, dc in next 2 tr, 2 dc in next tr, *dc in next 3 tr, 2 dc in next st; repeat from * around, slip st to first dc – 30 dc. Fasten off.

Flower (make 2)

With smaller hook and 1 strand of **D**, ch 6, join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, 12 dc in ring; join with slip st to front loop of first dc – 12 dc.

Round 2: Ch 2 (counts as first htr and throughout), 2 htr in same front loop as joining, working in front loops only, 3 htr in each dc; join with slip st in first htr – 36 htr.

Round 3: Working behind last round, slip st in first back loop of Round 1, ch 3 (counts as first tr), tr in same loop, 2 tr in each back loop; join with slip st to first tr – 24 tr.

Round 4: Ch 2, 2 htr in same st as joining, 3 htr in each tr around; join with slip st in first htr – 72 htr. Fasten off.

Bottom Wing Decorations

Oval (make 2)

Work same as Blue Circle Rounds 1-3, do not fasten off **E** at the end of Round 3.

Note: Continue working in rows to Last Round.

Row 4: Ch 1, dc in same st as joining and in next 8 dc, turn – 9 dc.

Rows 5-7: Ch 1, dc2tog, dc in each dc to last 2 dc, dc2tog, turn – 3 dc at end of Row 7.

Last Round: Ch 1, dc3tog, dc evenly spaced around to last dc, 3 dc in last dc. Fasten off.

ASSEMBLY

Using photograph as a guide, sew decorations on wings.

With 2 strands of **F** threaded together and beginning at each wing's Row 1, sew together through upper wing Row 27 and lower wing Row 38. Repeat for second set of wings.

Align top inner edge of left wings to Row 60 of body. With 2 strands of **A** threaded together, sew wings to body ending at Row 16 of body. Repeat for right wings.

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FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Cocoon measures 78 cm [31"] circumference and 58.5 cm [23"] long, with brim folded over.

COCOON

Ribbing

With larger hook, beginning at top edge, with 2 strands of **A** held together, ch 21.

Row 1: Ch 1, dc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch, turn – 20 dc.

Rows 2-82: Ch 1, working in back loops only, dc in each dc, turn.

Body

Row 1 (right side): Ch 1, working across ends of rows, dc in each row, turn – 82 dc.

Row 2: Ch 1, *dc in next 9 dc, 2 dc in next dc; repeat from * 7 times, dc in last 2 dc, turn – 90 dc.

Row 3: Ch 3, tr in each dc, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, dc in each tr, turn.

Rows 5-34: Repeat Row 3 and 4 fifteen times.

Row 35: Repeat Row 3.

Row 36: Ch 1, *dc in next 9 tr, dc2tog; repeat from * 7 times, dc in last 2 tr, turn – 82 dc.

Row 37: Repeat Row 3.

Row 38: Ch 1, *dc in next 8 tr, dc2tog; repeat from * 7 times, dc in last 2 tr, turn – 74 dc.

Row 39: Repeat Row 3.

Row 40: Ch 1, *dc in next 7 tr, dc2tog; repeat from * 7 times, dc in last 2 dc, turn – 66 dc.

Row 41: Ch 1, *dc in next 6 dc, dc2tog; repeat from * 7 times, dc in last 2 dc, turn – 58 dc.

Row 42: Ch 1, *dc in next 5 dc, dc2tog; repeat

from * 7 times, dc in last 2 dc, turn – 50 dc.

Row 43: Ch 1, *dc in next 4 dc, dc2tog; repeat from * 7 times, dc in last 2 dc, turn – 42 dc.

Row 44: Ch 1, *dc in next dc, dc2tog; repeat from * across, turn – 28 dc.

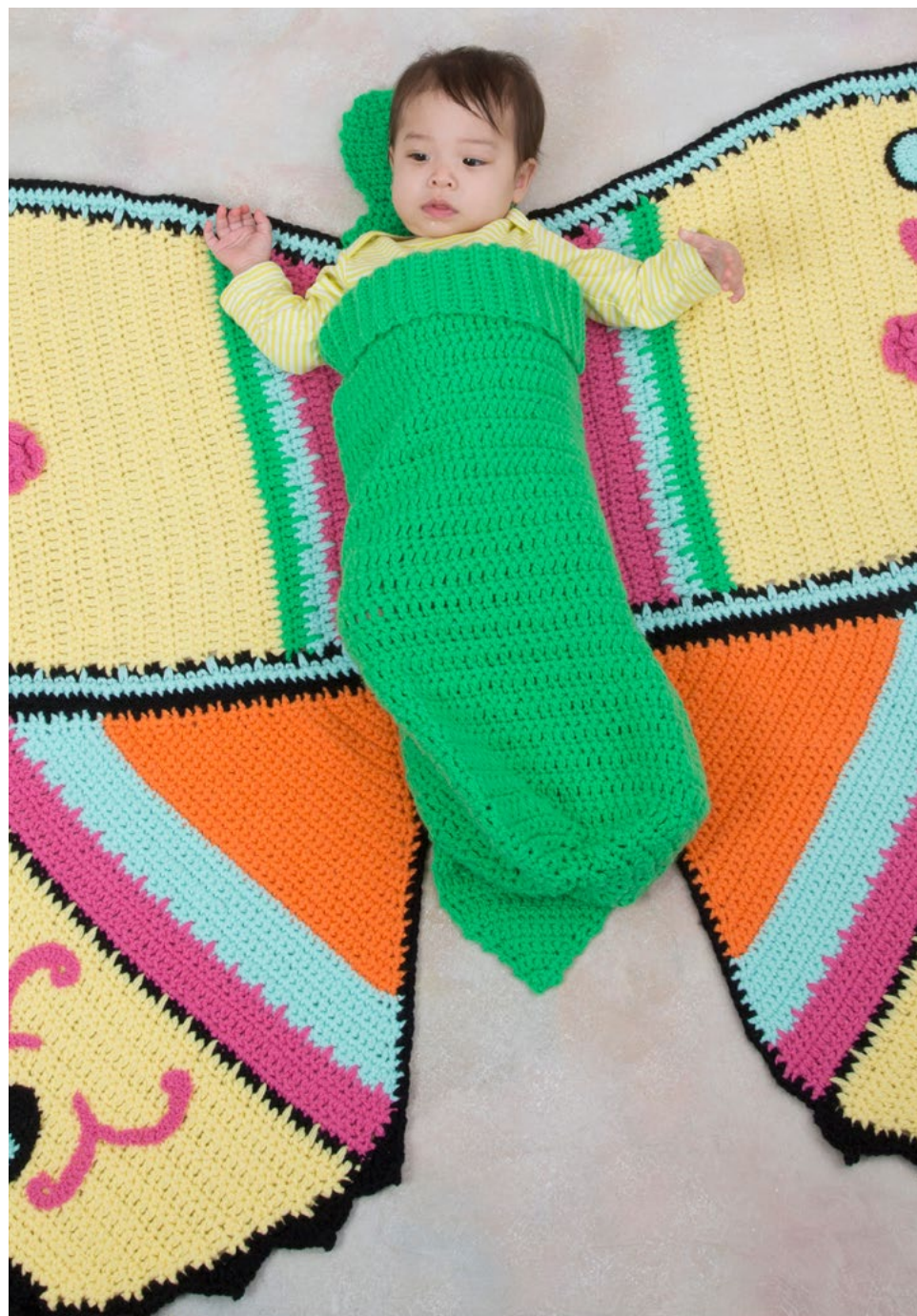
Row 45: Ch 1, *dc in next dc, dc2tog; repeat from * 8 times, dc in last dc – 19 dc. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Sew through stitches of last row, inserting needle through first stitch again to form a ring; pull tightly to close ring. Sew back seam of cocoon. Fold ribbing in half over top. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **htr** = half treble crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together; **tr** = triple or treble crochet; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; ***** or ****** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.



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
