What you will need:
RED HEART® Anne Geddes Baby"': 2 balls of 00100 Lily A; 1 skein each of 00112 Night Night B, 00902 Ladybug C and 00691 Grass D

Crochet Hook: 4.25 mm [US G-6]
Yarn needle, stitch marker and three $13 \mathrm{~mm}\left[1 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}\right]$ sew-on snaps

TENSION/GAUGE: 14 sts = 10 cm [4"]; 16 rows = 10 cm [4"] in Puff stitch pattern. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the tension/gauge

## Snowman Cutie Baby Set

Your little snowman will be ready for the winter season in this huggable crocheted outfit. Hat has attached scarf, puff stitch sweater is closed with big black "coal" buttons and red boots have white cuffs and black soles.

Sweater directions are for child's size 6 months. Changes for 12 months and 18 months are in parentheses.

## Hat directions are for size Small. Changes

 for Large are in parentheses.Finished Chest: $51[56,61] \mathrm{cm}[20(22,24)$ " $]$
Finished Length: $22.5(26.5,30.5) \mathrm{cm}$ [9
(10½, 12)"]
Hat: To fit head size 38 (43) cm [15 (17)"]

## Special Abbreviations

Puff stitch (Puff st): [Yarn over, insert hook in next st, yarn over, draw up a loop] 4 times in same st, yarn over, draw yarn through all 9 loops on hook.
double crochet 2 together (dc2tog): [Insert hook in next st, yarn over, draw yarn through st] twice, yarn over, draw yarn through 3 loops on hook.

## Puff Stitch Pattern

## (Worked on a multiple of $\mathbf{4 + 1} \mathbf{~ s t}$ )

Ch a multiple of $4+1+1$ (for turning ch).
Set-up Row: Dc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in each ch across turn.
Row 1 (wrong side): Ch 1, dc in each of first 3 dc , *puff st in next dc**, dc in each of next 3 sts; repeat from * across, ending last repeat at **, dc in last ch, turn.
Row 2: Ch 1, dc in each st across, turn.
Row 3: Ch 1, dc in first dc, *puff st in next dc, dc in each of next 3 dc ; repeat from * across, turn.

## Row 4: Repeat Row 2.

Repeat Rows 1-4 for Puff st pattern.

## SWEATER

Sweater is worked in one piece to underarm, then divided into fronts and back.

## Body

With A, ch $70(78,86)$.
Set-up Row: Dc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in each ch across turn - $69(77,85)$ dc.
Work even in Puff st pattern until body measures $12.5(15,18) \mathrm{cm}[5(6,7)$ "] from beginning, ending with a wrong side row.

## Divide for Fronts and Back

Right Front
Row 1: Work in pattern across first $17(19,21)$ sts, turn.
Work even in pattern on $17(19,21)$ sts until
front measures $5(6.5,7.5) \mathrm{cm}\left[2\left(2 \frac{1}{2}, 3\right) "\right]$, ending with a right side row.

## Shape Neck

Next Row: Work in pattern across to last 8 sts, turn, leaving remaining sts unworked -9 (11, 13) sts.

Work even on $9(11,13)$ sts until Right Front measures $10(11.5,12.5) \mathrm{cm}[4(41 / 2,5)$ "] from beginning of armhole. Fasten off.

## Back

Row 1: With right side facing, join A with a slip st in first st to the left of Row 1 of Right Front, work in established pattern across first 35 (39, 43) sts, turn, leaving remaining sts unworked. Work even on $35(39,43)$ sts, until Back measures $10(11.5,12.5) \mathrm{cm}[4(41 / 2,5)$ "] from beginning of armhole. Fasten off.

## Left Front

Row 1: With right side facing, join A with a slip st in first st to the left of Row 1 of Back, work in established pattern across last $17(19,21)$ sts, turn.
Work even in pattern on $17(19,21)$ sts until Left Front measures $5(6.5,7.5) \mathrm{cm}[2(21 / 2$, 3 )"], ending with a wrong side row.

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## Shape Neck

Next Row: Work in pattern across to last 8 sts, turn, leaving remaining sts unworked -9 (11, 13) sts.

Work even on $9(11,13)$ sts until Right Front measures $10(11.5,12.5) \mathrm{cm}[4(41 / 2,5)$ "] from beginning of armhole. Fasten off.
Sew Fronts to Back at shoulders.

## Sleeve (make 2)

With A, ch $22(22,26)$.
Set-up Row: Dc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in each ch across turn - $21(21,25) \mathrm{dc}$.
Work in pattern, inc 1 st at each end of every 4 th row $4(6,7)$ times. Then, work even in pattern on $29(33,39)$ sts until Sleeve measures $15(18,20.5) \mathrm{cm}[6(7,8)$ "] from beginning. Fasten off, leaving a long sewing length. Sew Sleeve seams. Sew top of Sleeves into armholes.

## Left Front Band

Row 1: With right side facing, join A with a slip st to top left-hand corner of Left Front edge, ch 1, work $27(33,38)$ dc evenly spaced across to bottom edge, turn.
Rows 2-4: Ch 1, dc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

## Right Front Band

Row 1: With right side facing, join A with a slip st to bottom right-hand corner of Right Front edge, ch 1, work $27(33,38)$ dc evenly spaced across to neck shaping, turn.
Rows 2-4: Ch 1, dc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

## Edging

Row 1: Ch 1, dc in each st across Right Front to neck, 2 dc in corner st, dc evenly around
neck edge, 2 dc in corner st, dc in each st across Left Front edge to bottom edge. Turn. Row 2: Ch 1, dc in each st across Left Front to neck, 2 dc in corner st, dc evenly around neck edge, 2 dc in corner st, dc in each st across Right Front edge to bottom edge. Fasten off.

## Big Black Buttons (make 3)

With B, ch 2.
Round 1: Work 6 dc in 2nd ch from hook, do not join, work in a spiral. Mark beginning of each round, moving marker up as work progresses.
Round 2: 2 dc in each dc around - 12 dc . Round 3: Dc in each dc around.
Round 4: [Dc2tog over next 2 sts] around -6 sts. Fasten off, leaving a 30.5 cm [12"] sewing length. Thread sewing length onto yarn needle. Run through top of sts in last round and gather.

## FINISHING

With Right Front Band over left for girls and Left Front Band over Right for boys, sew snaps to appropriate front band starting 2.5 cm [1"] below neck edge, and spacing remaining snaps $5(6.5,7.5) \mathrm{cm}[2(21 / 2,3)$ "] apart down front band. Sew one Button over each snap on top band.
Weave in ends.

## HAT

## Back

## With A, ch 2.

Round 1: Work 8 dc in 2nd ch from hook, do not join, work in a spiral. Mark beginning of each round, moving marker up as work progresses.
Round 2: 2 dc in each dc around - 16 dc . Round 3: *Dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc; repeat from * around $\neg-24 \mathrm{dc}$.
Round 4: *Dc in each of next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc; repeat from * around -32 dc .

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Round 5: *Dc in each of next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc; repeat from * around - 40 dc .
Round 6: *Dc in each of next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc; repeat from * around - 48 dc .
Round 7: *Dc in each of next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc; repeat from * around -56 dc .
Round 8: *Dc in each of next $6 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc; repeat from * around - 64 dc .
Round 9: *Dc in each of next $7 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc; repeat from * around - 72 dc. Do not fasten off.

## Size L Only

Round 10: *Dc in each of next $8 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc; repeat from * around - 80 dc . Do not fasten off.

## All Sizes

Sides
Work now progresses in rows
Row 1 (wrong side): Ch 1 , turn, dc in each of first 53 (61) sts, turn, leaving remaining sts unworked.
Work even in pattern until Sides measure 12.5 (15) cm [5 (6)"] from beginning. Fasten off A.

## Attached Scarf

Row 1: With C, ch 32, with right side of Hat facing, *working across side edge of Side, [dc2tog over next 2 row-end sts]*; repeat from * to * across to back neck edge, starting in base of last st worked, [dc2tog over next 2 sts], then work [dc2tog over next 2 sts] 9 times across back neck, repeat from * to * across other side edge of Sides, ch 33, turn. Row 2 (wrong side): With C, htr in 3rd ch from hook, htr in each ch and st across - 94 (98) htr. Drop C to be picked up later. Do not turn.

Row 3: With wrong side facing, join D with a slip st in beginning ch-2 of Row 2, ch 2 (counts as htr here and throughout), htr in each st across, turn. Drop D to be picked up later.
Row 4 (right side): Pick up C through last st of previous row, ch 2, htr in each st across. Drop C to be picked up later. Do not turn.
Row 5: Pick up D through last st of previous row, ch 2, htr in each st across, turn. Drop D to be picked up later.
Repeat Rows 4-5 once, then repeat Row 3 once. Fasten off C and D. Weave in ends.

## B00TS (make 2)

Cuff
With A, ch 24 , and without twisting ch, join into a ring with a slip st in first ch.
Round 1: Ch 2, htr in each ch around; join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-2-24 htr.
Round 2: Ch 2, htr in each htr around; join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-2. Repeat Round 2 until cuff measures 10 cm [4"] from beginning. Fasten off A.

## Foot

Round 1: With right side facing, skip first 8 sts, join C with a slip st in next st, ch 1, dc in each st around; join with a slip st in first dc 24 dc .
Round 2: Ch 1, dc in each dc around; join with a slip st in first dc.

## Instep

Work now progresses in rows.
Row 1: Ch 1, dc in each of first 9 sts, turn,
leaving remaining sts unworked -9 sts.
Rows 2-4 (6): Ch 1, dc in each dc across, turn. Row 5 (7): Ch 1, dc2tog over next 2 sts, dc in each of next 5 sts, dc2tog over last 2 sts - 7 sts. Fasten off.

## Continue Foot

Work now progresses in rounds.
Round 1: With right side facing, join C in 8th st at centre back of heel, ch 2 (counts as htr), htr in each of next 7 sts, working in row-end sts, work 4 (6) htr evenly spaced across edge of instep, 2 htr in corner, htr in each of 7 sts across toe, 2 htr in corner, work 4 (6) htr evenly spaced across edge of instep, htr in each of next 7 sts on back of heel; join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-2 - 34 (38) sts. Rounds 2-3: Ch 2, htr in each st around join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-2. Fasten off.

## Sole

Round 1: With right side facing, join B with a slip st in first st, ch 1, skip first st, dc2tog over next 2 sts, $d c$ in each of next 12 (14) sts, dc2tog over next 2 sts, dc in next st, dc2tog over next 2 sts, dc in each of next 12 (14) sts, dc2tog over next 2 sts; join with a slip st in first st - 29 (33) sts.
Round 2: Ch 1, dc2tog over next 2 sts, dc in each of next 10 (12) sts, dc2tog over next 2 sts, dc in next st, dc2tog over next 2 sts, dc in each of next 10 (12) sts, dc2tog over next 2 sts; join with a slip st in first st - 25 (29) sts. Round 3: Ch 1, dc2tog over next 2 sts, dc in each of next 8 (10) sts, dc2tog over next 2 sts, dc in next st, dc2tog over next 2 sts, dc in each of next 8 (10) sts, dc2tog over next 2 sts; join with a slip st in first st - 21 (25) sts.

Round 4: Ch 1, dc2tog over next 2 sts, dc in each of next 6 (8) sts, dc2tog over next 2 sts, dc in next st, dc2tog over next 2 sts, dc in each of next 6 (8) sts, dc2tog over next 2 sts; join with a slip st in first st - 17 (21) sts. Fasten off, leaving a 30.5 cm [12"] sewing length. Sew Sole seam closed, lengthwise. Weave in ends. Fold cuff down.

## Abbreviations

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; ch = chain; $\mathbf{c m}=$ centimeters; dc = double crochet; htr = half treble crochet; $\mathrm{mm}=$ millimeters; st(s) = stitch(es); yo = yarn over; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** $=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
