



FITZ ROY

Finished Measurements: Cowl is approx. 25¼" [64 cm] in circumference. Hood is approx. 14½" [37 cm] tall.

If you'd like to make this Cowl with attached Hood, you will need the following materials:

6, 50 g (55 yd/50 m) balls **Schachenmayr Lova** (30% wool, 67% acrylic, 3% polyamide) color #00094 Art Deco

Size N/P/15 US [10 mm] crochet hook

Bias tape (32" long x 1¼" wide) [0.80 m long x 3 cm wide], color Grey

Drawstring, 39" [1 m] long, color Grey

Stitch marker, yarn needle

My Mountain logo label

Gauge: 10 sts x 13 rows = 4" x 4" [10 x 10 cm] in Crochet patt for Hood

Terminology

1 single crochet (sc) US = 1 double crochet (dc) UK

1 double crochet (dc) US = 1 treble crochet (tr) UK

1 treble (tr) US = 1 double treble (dtr) UK

Pattern uses US crochet terms.

These are the crochet patterns you will need to make this project:

Crochet pattern for Hood

Row 1: Ch 1, *working 1 sc, ch 1, skip 1 st; rep from *, end work 1 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, *ch 1, skip 1 sc, 1 sc into ch-1 space; rep from *, end working 1 sc.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 throughout.



Crochet pattern for Cowl

Work in rnds. Beg rnds with ch 2 (count as 1 sc) or ch 3 (count as 1 dc). Join rnds with a sl st.

Rnd 1: Work dc around.

Rnd 2: Work 1 sc in each st around.

Rnd 3: *Work 1 dc in next st of prev rnd, work 1 fptr around the st 2 rnds below; rep from * around.

Rep Rnds 2 and 3 throughout.

Let's get started!

Here are the instructions:

Hood

Ch 84 + ch 1. Work first sc on first row in 3rd ch from hook then beg Crochet patt for Hood. Cont in patt until piece meas 7¾" [20 cm] from beg. PM in 49th st of last row worked. Next row: Patt across first 36 sts only. Turn. Cont in patt on these 36 sts for a further 3¼" [8 cm]. Cut yarn and fasten off.

Rejoin yarn at marker and patt across last 36 sts. Turn. Cont in patt on these 36 sts for a further 3¼" [8 cm]. Cut yarn and fasten off.

Sew top long edges of the Hood together, then sew short edges of the 2 extensions to the gap between the halves as shown by arrows on schematic. Overlap and sew the lower Hood edges by 1½" [4 cm] to form a ring.

Cowl

Beg at center back of Hood, join yarn and work 58 dc around lower edge of Hood. Sl st to first dc to join in the rnd. PM to indicate beg of rnd. Beg Crochet patt for Cowl and work until Cowl meas 4¾" [12 cm] from pick-up rnd, end after working rnd 3 of patt. Cut yarn and fasten off.

Finishing

With yarn needle, weave in all ends. On WS, sew bias tape along the Cowl pick-up row for drawstring casing. Weave drawstring through sts at bottom edge of Hood and through bias tape casing. Knot each end of the drawstring. Sew on the My Mountain label.

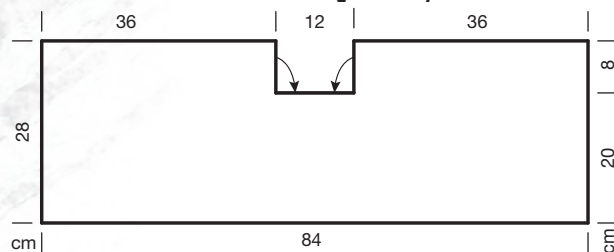
You've done it – your My Mountain Cowl with attached Hood is finished!
